TRAVEL INFORMATION

In addition to a valid passport, South Africa generally requires an entry visa. Currently no inoculations are required. (However, you should consult your travel agency beforehand in this regard) OR contact Gracy Travel International on 210-698-2611

TRIP CANCELLATION INSURANCE

Clients should ensure that they are covered for their safari by a trip travel protection plan, available through S.C.I. on www.huntandtravel.com, as well as for all rifles, clothing and equipment.

NB: FIREARMS REGULATIONS

New legislation has necessitated the completion of comprehensive documentation for the temporary importation of firearms and ammo. Please ensure that you obtain all the relevant information through the H&G office, prior to your arrival. Hunters & Guides recommend to their clients that they get in direct contact with our Firearms Clearing Agency Hunters Support by e-mail air2000@global.co.za / anne@air-2000.com For a small fee they will complete the clearing documentation prior to your arrival and escort you through customs. **We cannot recommend this service highly enough.**

QUOTATION INCLUDES

- The full time services of a PH and complete team including trackers, skinners, cook and camp assistants.
- Full accommodation and camp equipment, including linen, towels, and daily laundry.
- Full catering including fresh fruit and vegetables and normal consumption of alcoholic beverages. Special tastes will be catered for if enough advance notification is given.
- All transport during the safari i.e. One 4-wheel drive-hunting car per Professional Hunter.
- Preservation and handling of trophies in the field.
- Cost of hunting licences.

QUOTATION DOES NOT INCLUDE

- Airport 'meet and greet' at first airport upon arrival for firearms clearance (fee to be advised)
- Vehicle transfer from JHB International or other commercial airports to the hunting areas will be charged at \$ 500 per hunting vehicle, per round trip.
- Extra car hire may be required for family safaris or groups of more than two people. An air-conditioned venture bus or Microbus will be hired, and a quote will be given depending on the size of the group.
- Charters, other internal flights to and from hunting areas, as well as hotel accommodation before, during and after the contracted safari period.
- Trophy charges.
- Any sundry charge in the lodge e.g. telephone.
- Gratuities to camp staff (Recommended \$100 / day / client.)
- Firearm rental - \$40 per day per rifle or shotgun.
- Ammunition at cost.
- Sundry or extra services will be charged at cost plus 10% administration fee, plus the mandatory Government VAT of 14%.
- Value Added Tax (VAT) currently @ 14% payable on daily rate only.
- In terms of the VAT Act of South Africa, any animal hunted, but not exported, e.g. wounded and lost, will attract a levy of 14% VAT of the trophy fee. This does not apply to trophies for export.
- There will be a \$10 Conservation Levy per trophy hunted by clients.
- Field preparation of trophies and transport to taxidermist for export - \$ 250.
- Compulsory medical evacuation insurance at a fee of \$100 / hunter and \$100 / observer
- Taxidermist handling charges and shipping costs.
- **The night of arrival in camp, if not a hunting day, will be charged at observer rates.**
- Cost of hunting licenses and CITES permits where applicable.

TERMS OF BUSINESS

- A deposit of 50% on total daily rate is required to confirm bookings - balance payable 70 days prior to the start of the Safari.
- Trophy charges are applicable only to animals actually bagged or wounded and lost.
- Prices are subject to change without notice. Safaris are exposed to local currency exchange rate risk due to fluctuation in the value of the US Dollar. This in mind, Hunters and Guides reserves the right to adjust prices to reflect these fluctuations in the event that it becomes necessary to do so.
- All payments must be made in cash, travellers cheques, or electronic bank transfer.
- **A detailed summary of our terms and conditions will be forwarded to you with your Safari Contract when confirming your booking, or on request.**
